

Safety Vests: a friendly reminder about National Gear Rules that started on the 1st of July 2022. There is a firm policy, no exemption will be granted. You need a Beta level 3 vest that meets current standards or will not be allowed to jump any fixed objects at a Rally, Competition or using Pony club Grounds for training.

Riding at the club grounds

As a Riding Member at Mountain, you can ride at the club grounds when the grounds are not booked or used. There is no cost involved - this benefit comes with your riding membership.

Book before you ride:

To use the grounds, you must book first by emailing to our bookings

email:<u>mountainpcbookings@gmail.com</u>. or phone /message on 0419433357 Include the date, names of rider(s) and anyone else who will be present.

Our bookings coordinator, Emma Cobcroft, will confirm if the grounds are available. You will be given a code for the keysafe to access the padlock key. Please do not share this code with anyone.

Stick to the rules.

There are a few rules you must follow:

- Club grounds use is a club member privilege. You can invite a riding non-member as long as this person is a financial EA or pony club member. A non-refundable day fee of \$30 per rider applies, payable to the club in advance. You must include this person in your booking request.
- An adult must be present on the ground (unmounted) at all times while using the grounds. This is for your safety!
- If you bring an instructor or coach, this person must have coach or instructor insurance.
- All attendees must adhere to the rules and policies as set out by PCASA and Mountain PC this includes the pony club gear rules.
- Put your dog on a leash if it may pose a risk to neighbouring animals or wildlife.
- Treat our facilities with respect. Clean up after yourself and put things back where they belong.
- Keep the access gate closed while you're on the grounds and lock all doors, windows and the gate when you leave.
- Report any damage/issues of concern to the club email (or where you can, fix it. We're all caretakers of our grounds).

Canteen Duty involves.....

9.30 / 10.00am

- Sweep and clean toilets, re-stock toilet paper and hand towel
- Sweep under verandah
- Fill large urn 1/3 full and light (heating water first on stove top kettle- heats quicker)
- Take out plates and cutlery

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• Fill container for kids cordial and put out plastic cups

11.00 / 11.30am

- Cook meat on bbq
- Cut up and wrap cakes if needed and make up salads ready for lunch

- Put washing liquid, tea towels and drying rack at outside sink
- Once lunch is ready, make up plate for instructors <u>"Instructor Wendy Marston is allergic to bacon"</u>
- Take money for lunch tickets and serve food where needed (cost \$5.00 per person or \$15.00 per family)

After lunch

- Clean salad containers for collection, wash BBQ meat containers and clean bbq
- Stack chairs against wall, sweep and MOP floors
- Empty bins into large skip, including toilet bins and replace bin liners
- Turn off all gas bottles hot water urn (indoors) and bbq/stove (located at the back outside)
- Empty fridges and leave doors slightly open for airing
- Close all windows
- Someone is to take home dirty tea towels to wash and bring back to next rally.



The Formal Uniform (All rallies and competitions)

The formal shirt and woollen jumper are available through our Pony Club and the ties can be purchased through the club or the Uniform Shop.
